

VILLAGE OF DRAKE

Bylaw No. 2-93

A bylaw to classify, regulate and license any business, trade or calling not assessable for the purposes of business taxation in respect to their business, trade or calling.

The Council of the Village of Drake in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. No person shall carry on any business, trade or calling set out in section 8 of this bylaw within the municipality unless he has in his possession a valid and subsisting license for the purposes issued in accordance with the provisions of this bylaw.
2. The Clerk/Administrator of the municipality is hereby authorized to issue a license to any person carrying on a business, trade or calling in the municipality.
  - (a) Who is not assessable by the municipality for the purposes of business taxation in respect to that business, trade or calling; and
  - (b) Who makes application for such license stating specifically the nature of his business in the municipality; and
  - (c) Who tenders with his application the proper license fee as provided for in section 8.
3. Every license issued under the authority of this bylaw unless suspended or revoked shall expire on the thirty-first day of December of the year of issue.
4. Where a license is issued after the 1st day of September in any year, the fee payable under section 8 shall be reduced by 30 per cent.
5. Every license issued shall specifically state the kinds of services, goods or merchandise which the licensee is authorized to offer for sale or take orders for as the case may be and whether in the case of goods or merchandise, he may offer the same for sale by retail or by public auction or both. Such license shall also state the restriction as set forth in section 6 hereof.
6. No person to whom a license has been granted under this bylaw shall offer for sale services, goods or merchandise or solicit orders for future delivery of goods or merchandise within the village:
  - (a) other than a kind or kinds described in the license; or
  - (b) by any method except as stated in the license; or
  - (c) at any time or during any period when shops within the village offering for sale or taking orders for similar services, goods or merchandise are required by village bylaw to be and remain closed.

7. Every person licensed under this bylaw shall, at all reasonable times, upon request of the Clerk/Administrator, by bylaw enforcement officer or license inspector, or any peace officer, produce such license for inspection purposes.
8. Subject to section 4, the fee payable for a license under this bylaw shall be as follows:
- a) For a Transient Trader  
 "Transient Trader" means a person carrying on business in the municipality
    - (a) offers goods or merchandise for sale by retail or auction; or
    - (b) solicits any person who is not a wholesaler or retail dealer for orders for the future delivery of goods or merchandise; and who is not a person that is;
    - (c) required to be licensed under the DIRECT SELLERS ACT; or
    - (d) assessable for the purpose of business taxation in respect of that business. ....\$ 50.00
  
  - b) General Contractor & Engineering Firms - who enters into contracts for the construction, alteration, repair or removal of buildings or structures. .... \$100.00
  
  - c) Jobbing & Subcontractors - includes trucking, gravelling, excavating, landscaping, bricklayers, stonemasons, carpenters, drywallers, roofing and metal installation of eavestroughing, cabinet work, floor covering - tile, linoleum and rug laying, floor finishing, painters, decorators, insulators, plumbing, heating and electricians and refrigeration service & installation. .... \$ 50.00
  
  - d) Caterers (Except catering by local church groups and service organizations ..... \$ 25.00
  
  - e) Accountants & Auditors ..... \$ 50.00
  
  - f) Cleaning Services - Any person not otherwise assessed a business tax and who is not a direct seller by virtue of the DIRECT SELLERS ACT, 1965, for such a business shall pay therefor a license fee of:
    - (a) rug and/or upholstery cleaning ..... \$ 25.00
    - (b) Chimney Sweep & Furnace Cleaners ..... \$ 25.00
    - (c) Any other business of a similar nature ..... \$ 25.00
  
  - g) Unclassified - any trade or business not specifically provided for
    - (a) Providing any goods or services to any one customer less than \$50.00 in value ..... local \$ 15.00  
 ..... outside area \$ 25.00
    - (b) Providing any goods or services to any one customer greater than \$50.00 ..... local \$ 25.00  
 ..... outside area \$ 50.00

9. Any person who contravenes the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and upon conviction, shall be liable to (the Penalty provided for by the General Penalty Bylaw of the municipality or other specified penalty).

10. Repeal of Bylaw

Bylaw No. 27 is hereby repealed.

11. Effective Date

This Bylaw shall come into force and effect on the date of final passing thereof.
